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1. Some Recent History

The very first Earth Day was April 22, 1970, founded by Senator Gaylord Nelson of Wisconsin.

The urgent concern for the environment, a mere 47 years ago (as of 11.2017), was climate change. The climate change the scientific community and University elite were most fearful of was global cooling. A good number of leading scientists were predicting an irreversible slide into a new Ice Age. Yes, just a few years ago, the smartest environmentalists among us, who led the Earth Day movement, published scientific papers, and were widely published and covered by media outlets, were stating and providing scientific data regarding their very real fear the earth was cooling and the world as we knew it would not last another 20 years.

"...Aerosol cooling, Rasool and Schneider, Science, July 1971, p 138, "Atmospheric Carbon Dioxide and Aerosols: Effects of Large Increases on Global Climate" is the best exemplar. This contains the quote that quadrupling aerosols could decrease the mean surface temperature (of Earth) by as much as 3.5 degrees K. If sustained over a period of several years, such a temperature decrease could be sufficient to trigger an ice age!"

Science magazine (Dec. 10, 1976) warned about "extensive Northern Hemisphere glaciation." Taken from a larger quote, "When such a model is applied to Vernekar's (39) astronomical projections, the results indicate that the long-term trend over the next 20,000 years is towards extensive Northern Hemisphere glaciation and cooler climate (80)." The article further stated "these would be the tendencies in the absence of human perturbation of the climate system." (JD Hays, J Imbrie and NJ Shackleton, Science, v194, #4270, p1121, 1976/12/10.

In 1974, the National Science Board reported "During the last 20 to 30 years, world temperature has fallen, irregularly at first but more sharply over the last decade. Judging from the record of the past interglacial ages, the present time of high temperatures should be drawing to an end, leading into the next ice age."

The newspapers, magazines and TV and Radio joined in the promotion of the growing concern and in some quarters, genuine efforts to impose governmental controls on this out of control slide into a frigid world caused by human pollution of the planet.

The New York Times, Aug. 14, 1976, reported "many signs that Earth may be headed for another ice age."

Random House published a book titled "THE WEATHER CONSPIRACY, coming of the New Ice Age."

The prospect is literally chilling. The ultimate in climate control — 20 degrees cooler not only inside but outdoors as well.

And if by now we are accustomed, if not inured, to the physical threat of pollution, along comes a warning there may also be dire political consequences.

Dr. Arnold Reitze, an expert in the legal aspects from Cleveland's Case Western Reserve University, suggests pollution, or the effort to control it, could be fatal to our concept of a free society.

As likely inevitable restraints on the individual and mass, Reitze suggests:

- **Outlawing the internal combustion engine** for vehicles and outlawing or strick controls over all forms of combustion.
- **Rigid controls on the marketing of new products**, which will be required to prove a minimum pollution potential.
- **Controls on all research and development**, to be halted at the slightest prospect of additional pollution.
- **Possibly even population controls**, the number of children per family prescribed and punishment for exceeding the limit.

In Reitze's view, "We will be forced to sacrifice democracy by the laws that will protect us from further pollution."

2. Global Warming, Consensus or Conflict?

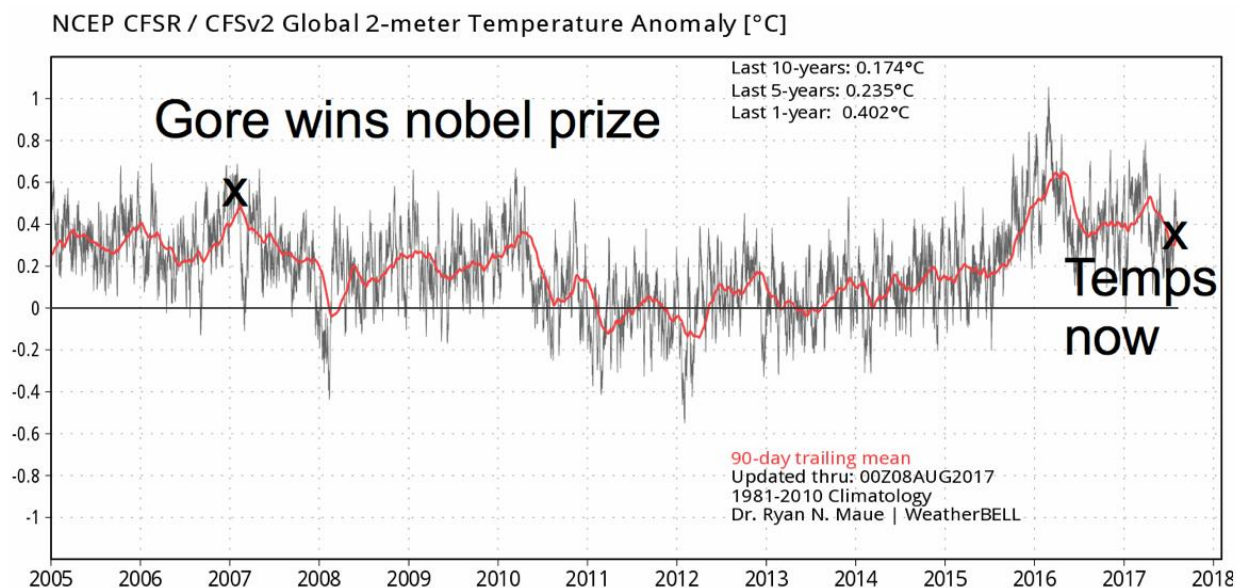
There are actually four models which scientists, meteorologists fall into. The often stated “95% of all scientists in the world agree that climate change is caused by man and can be reversed by government intervention” is a statement that can be and should be challenged.

- 36% Believe man is the cause for global warming primarily by fossil fuel CO2 emissions
- 24% Nature is Overwhelming and its cycles are the cause
- 17% Hold to a view that both nature and man are the cause but are skeptical of cause modeling showing man can prevent climate changes.
- 10% Believe the causes are natural and that government intervention will be economically negative
- 5% Believe the causes are both natural and human, but are skeptical of modeling used

3 Global Warming as a Fact

(1.1-degree Fahrenheit (0.59-degree Celsius) ocean surface temperature **over last 135 years**)

“During 1997, the world set another temperature record, continuing a long-term global warming trend for which humans are mostly responsible, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) scientists reported in January 1998. By international agreement, the normal temperature for Earth is defined as 61.7°F, the average for the years 1961-1990. Land and ocean readings averaged three-quarters of a degree Fahrenheit above normal, topping the record set in 1990 by fifteen-hundredths of a degree. Counting the 1997 rise, the planet has warmed by more than 1 degree over the last century (Boyd, Robert).” *The Potential Effects of Global Warming*, by Thomas M. Socha, M.S.

This 1.1 degree F rise in temperature of the surface of the ocean over the last 100 years is further supported by the Live Science website, “The comparison showed a 1.1-degree Fahrenheit (0.59-degree Celsius) temperature increase at the ocean's surface over the last 135 years, a result corroborated by a large body of sea-surface temperature data that goes back more than 100 years.” (<https://www.livescience.com/19414-oceans-warming-135-years.html>)

Global Warming Causes

The causes of Global Warming that are outlined in this paper are considerably different from the single focus of the world's environmentalists on global warming which they claim is caused primarily by CO2 emissions by man and beast.

The causes summarized in this paper are both serious and potentially large contributors, are rarely mentioned in University and school curriculum or in popular media, and much less widely presented in today's scientific journals and media coverage of this important topic.

Serious causes/sources of global warming:

- Cause 1: The core of the earth, it is hotter than they thought and not that far away. We are sitting on top of a very hot stove.
- Cause 2: Change in cloud cover percentages on polar poles during winter solstices
- Cause 3: Active volcanos under the polar poles and ice caps
- Cause 4: Doubled CO2 emissions by human breathing of the swiftly growing population of earth, namely exhaling
- Cause 5: Increased Sun flare damage to the earth's ozone layer
- Cause 6: Methane gas escaping from the ocean floor
- Cause 7: The final predicted global warming we all ought to be most concerned about
